The Riverside Park will have:

Camping: \$10 for Friday & Saturday nights, flush toilets, village water, and 20 ft. x 20 ft. campsites. Use free-standing fire pans only. The park has a playground for the kids, a large pavilion with picnic tables, tennis court, basketball court, 3 ball fields and a dumpster available for trash. **No pets and no smoking please.** One vehicle allowed next to one campsite. Quiet after 10 pm. The park closes Sunday at sundown.

Breakfast: Saturday and Sunday 7am to 9 am at the Park in the Auxiliary Building. It's provided by the Forest Presbyterian and St. John's Catholic Churches. The Menu will be: hard boiled eggs, pancakes with Lewis County real maple syrup, sausage patty, fruit, coffee, tea, orange juice and home made muffins, all for \$5.00.
